To be eligible to receive a \$50 check in the mail, complete at least 1 of the following:**

- Blood test for breast cancer (CA 15-3)
- Blood test for colon cancer (CEA)
- Blood test for myeloma (serum protein electrophoresis)
- Blood test for ovarian cancer (CA 125)
- Blood test for prostate cancer (PSA)
- Blood test for triglycerides
- Bone marrow testing
- Breast ultrasound
- Chest X-ray
- Colonoscopy
- Fasting blood glucose test
- Flexible sigmoidoscopy
- Hemoccult stool analysis
- Mammography
- Pap smear
- Serum cholesterol test to determine HDL and LDL levels
- Stress test on a bicycle or treadmill
- Thermography
- Virtual colonoscopy

HIPP wellness benefit rules and information

- ✓ Screenings must be completed during the calendar year
- ✓ A covered spouse can also earn a benefit
- ✓ The benefit will only be paid for 1 test each calendar year, regardless of the test results
- ✓ This benefit is paid in addition to any other payments you and/or your covered spouse may receive under the HIPP policy
