

## Frequently Asked Questions About Filing A Hospital Indemnity Insurance Claim

The following questions and answers will help you file a Hospital Indemnity insurance claim with Standard Insurance Company (The Standard).

### When Should I File A Claim?

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File a claim if you or your covered dependent(s) are hospitalized due to a covered injury or sickness. See your Group Certificate for a list of hospitalization benefits covered under your policy.

### How Do I File A Claim?

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To file a claim online, go to [standard.com](http://standard.com), click on the following options:

- “Log in”
- “Don’t have an account? Start here” to create an account and follow the steps
- “Get Started”
- “Start a new Claim”
- “Hospital Indemnity”

To file a paper claim, go to [standard.com](http://standard.com), choose “File a Claim”, select “Start a Claim” and then click on “Paper Claim Forms” to download a claim form.

### When I Report My Claim, What Information Will I Need To Provide?

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You will be asked to provide the following information:

- Employer name: **Northwest Independent School District**
- Group Policy number: **759070**
- Name and Social Security number
- Nature of claim/medical information
- Physician’s contact information (name, address, phone and fax number)

A typical claim packet for hospital indemnity benefits contains the following documents to complete, sign and date:

- An Employee’s Statement, which may include support documentation
- An Attending Physician Statement
- An Authorization to Obtain and Release Information

The Standard may request medical records from your physician.

## Where Do I Send The Completed Paper Forms?

## How Long Does It Take To Make A Claim Decision?

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Once The Standard receives the required completed, signed and dated documents listed above, it will take approximately 5 business days to make a claim decision. If we have not made a decision within 5 business days, you will be notified with additional details.
