Login and PIN

Your login is your social security number, no dashes (123456789). Your pin is the last four digits of your social security number and the last two digits of your birth year (678977). It should be a 6-digit pin.

- Verify your personal information.
- Verify all dependent information including SSN and date of birth. This step is very important!
