



## How to file a claim for out-of-network dental services

The majority of Unum dental plan members' claims, including all in-network claims, are filed directly by dental offices. However, a few out-of-network providers may require the member to submit the claim and be reimbursed.

## FILING A CLAIM IS EASY.

## To file a claim, follow these simple steps:

- 1. Print or download the claim form from our secure AlwaysAssist website.
- 2. Fill out Part 1 of the dental claim form completely, including:
  - subscriber information (the employee or primary member of the plan)
  - patient information (the employee member or dependent who received dental services)
  - address information for payment/reimbursement delivery, and
  - appropriate signatures

Please note: All information requested on the form is required.

- 3. Ask your dental office to fill out Part 2 and provide a copy of a statement of services with a detailed receipt.

  We recommend keeping a copy of the statement of services, receipt and filled claim form for your records.
- 4. Fax or mail the completed form and dental documents to the locations listed at the top of the claim form. We do accept claims and supporting documents sent by e-mail, however, this is not as secure as fax.
- 5. We usually process claims within two weeks, if no additional information is needed from you or your dentist. Once approved, the benefit reimbursement will be mailed to the appropriate address as a hard copy check.
