If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. Services that charge a <u>copayment</u> , <u>prescription</u> <u>drugs</u> , and In-Network <u>preventive care</u> , <u>home health</u> , <u>skilled nursing</u> , and <u>hospice</u> are covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> .
