



Program Overview

The College For Futures Program in Partnership with ManhattanLife is a voluntary education discount program that provides access to exclusive, pre-negotiated tuition discounts at regionally accredited, not-for-profit colleges and universities. This is not insurance, and any ManhattanLife Accident Indemnity Plan policyholder is eligible. It is a value-added benefit designed to support long-term financial wellness.

Who Is Eligible?

- Any ManhattanLife Accident Indemnity Plan policyholder
- Family members of any ManhattanLife Accident Indemnity Plan policyholder, including spouses/partners, children, grandchildren, siblings, in-laws, and dependents
