# Your Member ID Card

Always show your Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Texas (BCBSTX) ID card – which includes a mobile version – when you visit a doctor or other place for care. Information on the ID card helps the care provider file your claim with us.

Depending on the type of plan you have, your card might have some or all of the information below.

- Subscriber name** – This may show the subscriber only or the dependent
- Identification number** – This number is unique to you and your covered dependents
- Group number** – This number is shared by everyone covered by the policy
- Network** – This is the name of your medical provider network
- Copays** – These are the fixed amounts you may have to pay when you visit a doctor, the ER or a specialist
- Rx Deductible/Out of Pocket Maximum** – Your RX deductible is the amount you must pay toward your prescription drug costs before your health plan begins to pay for your covered services. Your Rx Out of Pocket Max is the most you have to pay out of your own pocket for prescription drugs under your insurance plan during the year.  
Depending on your plan, you may have separate amounts for Rx or it may be combined with medical.\*
- BlueCard®** – The BlueCard symbol shows that you can get care while traveling or living in another Blue Cross and Blue Shield Plan's service area.

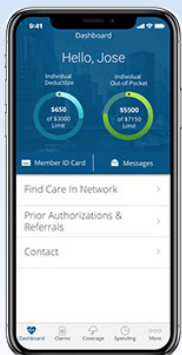
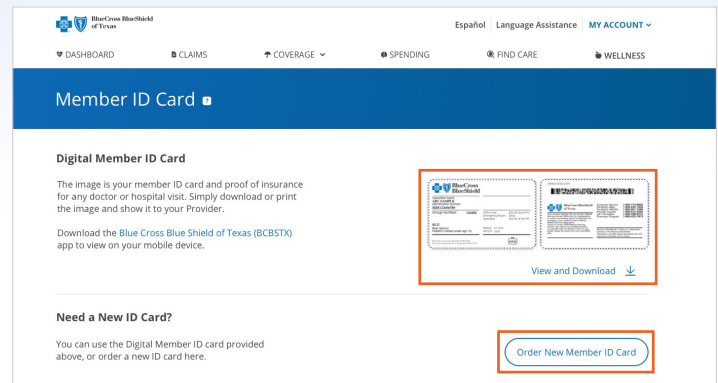
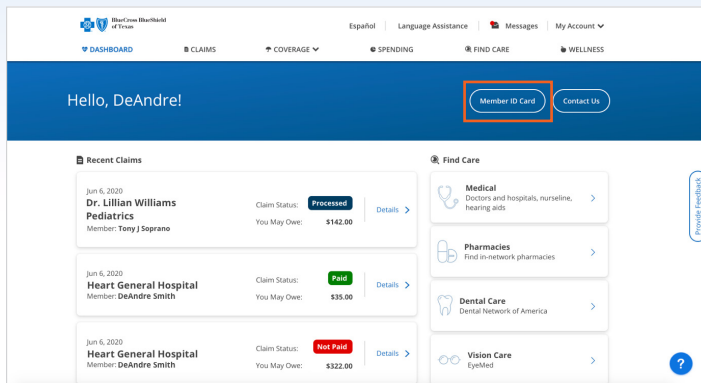
## Access the Secure Member Site
